Starting with the 1969 model Opel, vehicles produced at Antwerp, Belgium were finished with a lacquer. Vehicles produced at Bochum, Germany were finished with an enamel. The producing point is shown on the identification plate as follows:

**ANTWERP, BELGIUM:** The third digit of the identification number is the numeral 9.

**BOCHUM, GERMANY:** The third digit of the identification number is the numeral 1.

◀ In addition, the word "Acrylic" appears on the identification plate preceding the manufacturer's paint code. See illustrations to the left for examples.

Two stock numbers appear under some of the following chips. The upper numbers are Du Pont stock numbers matching Antwerp production. The lower numbers are Du Pont stock numbers matching Bochum production.
